PUT MEMBERS' TALENTS INTO ACTION

Looking for ways to get members to think about ways they can use their talents? Here's a quick activity:

- 1. Give each member a piece of paper and a pen.
- 2. Ask them to write their name and a short list of talents they have.
- 3. Ask them to list the different ways they use those talents in their lives and in club activities.
- 4. Allow time for advisors and officers to review members' lists.
- 5. Figure out what talents upcoming service projects require, such as organizing supplies or donations, creating posters, greeting people, etc.
- 6. Create a list of tasks and match them with members with related talents.

For members, it's a fun way to recognize all the skills they have. For the club, it's a great way to benefit from all that talent!
