Aktion Club Award and Contest Judging

District administrators can begin judging submissions for Aktion Club awards! Remember, district administrators will judge Speech, Club Video, Poster and Single Service awards to select district winners. After district winners are chosen, staff at Kiwanis International will judge first-place scrapbooks and analyze Annual Achievement Reports for Distinguished and Honor Clubs, as well as the other awards.

District administrators will receive an email by late October with the Award Judging Guide and a spreadsheet of award entries. After reviewing submissions, they will enter the first, second and third place winners in the spreadsheet, which the Kiwanis staff can access.

Winners will be notified via email by December 1 and will receive their digital badge and certificate. Award certificates will be mailed. Winners will also be announced in the January Aktion Club enewsletter.
