We hope those that receive these baskets feel comfort and joy.



## Project Plan:

Our goal was to provide some fun items to go into the 37 Easter baskets destined to go to RMCH. We started bunny tail Tootsie pops and brown paper bag Easter snack bags. It was a perfect way to give them to someone who needed a smile. We decided to make something “bright and cheery” and our paper flowers would do the trick!

We also decided on paper hearts on a popsicle stick to insert into the 37 books purchased for the baskets as well!



## Project Implementation:

A lot of folding and bending was involved in the flower preparation. A group of parents at another function were pulled into service to “prep” the flowers.



At our meeting, each Aktion club member was given instructions to create the flowers including a stem, leaves and a face for the front.





Following the creation of the flowers, we filled brown paper bags with snacks. We drew a bunny face on the bag, put a cotton ball on the back for a tail and tied them with a bow.



Next, we cut out red paper hearts and put them on popsicle sticks for bookmarks. We held them on with a sticker telling the recipient it was from our Aktion club!

## Final Results:


All the projects we worked on came together as a package to become part of the final delivery to RMDH.
