These Aktion Clubs strengthened the environment by working with local parks or Kiwanians. Learn how members identified needs in their community and worked to make a difference.

- [The Arc of Fresno Aktion Club](#) in the California-Nevada-Hawaii District planted trees to help prevent erosion along the San Joaquin River. Members also cleared brush for kayakers and canoers.
- Members of the [Westminster Aktion Club](#) in the Capital District kept a local park green by picking up trash on the walking trails monthly.
- To support bees and their pollinating efforts, the [Licking County Aktion Club](#) in the Ohio District distributed seeds and seed bombs to Kiwanians during an education day and donated native plants to the local Kiwanis club pollinator garden.

- **[National Audubon Society](#)**: Protects birds and their habitats through science, advocacy and education.
- **[National Wildlife Federation](#)**: The largest private, nonprofit conservation education and advocacy organization in the U.S.
- **[Natural Resources Defense Council \(NRDC\)](#)**: Uses legal action, science and advocacy to defend wildlife.
- **[The Ocean Cleanup](#)**: Researches, extracts and monitors plastic pollution in oceans and rivers globally.
- **[Wildlife Conservation Society](#)**: Operates comprehensive programs focused on species recovery and habitat protection.
- **[World Wildlife Fund](#)**: Focuses on reversing nature loss and biodiversity conservation.
