THANK YOUR SUPPORTERS!

Aktion Clubs run on the energy of members, but they also depend on the assistance of supporters. Whoever helps members and the club with supplies, funding, transportation, care, emotional support and service projects — those are your people! Remember to thank them throughout the year. Offer a special thank-you in one or more of these ways:

- Give them a handwritten thank-you card signed by a member or the entire club. Here are tips on [writing thank-you cards](#).

- Hold an annual thank-you party to celebrate all supporters with music, food and fun! Members can add a personal touch by giving attendees a thank-you gift.
